William E. Boden, MD, FACC, FAHA

Dr. William E. Boden is Director of Cardiovascular Services at Kaleida Health and Chief of Cardiology at Buffalo General and Millard Fillmore Hospitals. He received his medical degree from the State University of New York Upstate Medical Center, Syracuse. Dr. Boden completed his internal medicine training at Boston University Medical Center and his fellowship training in cardiology at Tufts University School of Medicine, both in Boston, Massachusetts. He is board certified in internal medicine and in the subspecialty of cardiovascular diseases. Dr. Boden is renowned for his contributions to a study at the University of Connecticut and Hartford Hospital which found that a little used treatment option for heart attack patients reduces the risk of death by 61 percent. Dr. Boden is a Professor of Medicine and Public Health at the State University of New York at Buffalo School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences.



Susan P. Graham, M.D.

Dr. Susan P. Graham is the Director of the Heart Failure Clinic at Kaleida Health's Buffalo General Hospital. She received her medical degree from the University of Texas Medical School, Houston and completed her Cardiology Fellowship training at the Medical College of Virginia, Richmond, Virginia. Dr. Graham is board certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine, Cardiovascular Diseases, and American Board of Nuclear Cardiology. She has participated in many research studies. Dr. Graham is a Clinical Professor in the Department of Medicine at the State University of New York at Buffalo.
